## **Charge to the Committee on Affiliated Council Status**

### **A. General Charge**

The Committee on Affiliated Council Status, as a sub-group of the Residents' Action Council, shall formulate a policy and implementation strategy regarding hall councils and their affiliation with the Residents' Action Council, while reviewing and making suggestions on the potential impact(s) on membership status(es).

### **B. Specific Duties**

The Committee shall formulate a report that includes:

1. Requirements for affiliation by hall council to the Residents' Action Council
2. Recommendations on a strategy for implementation by the Residents' Action Council
3. Recommendations on changes to membership status(es) due to any impact(s) by affiliation requirements

The Committee shall be prepared to present their report to the General Body.

### **C. Reporting Responsibilities**

The Co-Chairs of the Committee are charged specifically with the following duties:

1. Keeping the President apprised of the issues under consideration by the Committee
2. Informing the President of discussions within three days of any scheduled meeting
3. Submitting by Dec. 15, 2007, a written report of the Committee's decision and recommendations to the President

### **D. Membership**

The Committee shall consist of seven voting members, comprised of six representatives from hall councils with no more than two councils from a specific green and the Vice President for Administrative Affairs.

The Vice President for Marketing & Public Relations shall be an ex-officio member of the Committee without vote.

Jimmy Blair and Tim Hatcher of Biddle Hall Council shall be the Committee Co-Chairs, as appointed by the President and approved by the Executive Board, and shall be included in the voting members.

### **E. Minimum Number of Meetings**

The Committee shall convene at least two scheduled meetings before submitting a recommendation to the President.
